Children's Home Society Receives Grant to Fund Scholarships

Boise, IDAHO — January 28, 2010. The Children's Home Society of Idaho (CHS) received a grant from the Gladys E. Langroise Advised Fund in the Idaho Community Foundation (ICF). The grant, in the amount of \$110,000, will fund scholarships through CHS' Community Sponsorship Program, which allows children and families access to behavioral health services they could not otherwise afford.
