New Autism Clinic Celebrates Opening with a Ribbon Cutting

The Clinic provides comprehensive evaluation and treatment services to children and adolescents ages 18 months to 18 years with, or suspected of having, Autism. The Clinic consists of a team of experts in psychiatry, pediatric neuropsychology, clinical psychology, occupational therapy, and speech language pathology.
